OBJECTIVES



Transparency and accountability:

FAWOYDI always ensures that all projects are carried out according to plan and financial expenditures are strictly followed according to laid down policies and procedures.

Quality reproductive health services:

FAWOYDI ensures all staff are working to promote quality RH services. This is achieved through health education, capacity building, supplies of health equipment and drugs. FAWOYDI also constructs and renovates health facilities with support from partners.

This is another area the organization values, beneficiaries of FAWOYDI shall possess the knowledge, understanding and capability to identify and resolve their problems. Staff of FAWOYDI shall facilitate the process.

Key Achievements:

Fahimta Women and Youth Development Initiative (FAWOYDI) over the years have recorded tremendous successes in different areas of its operations.

REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

FAWOYDI take measures for Prevention and treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STIs), including HIV/AIDS via testing and referral, over 5,000 beneficiaries were tested for HIV and other STIs across her target communities of Ningi, Shira and Giade

Prevention of gender-based violence, including sexual violence through education and awareness Child health: mass growth monitoring



NUTRITION

FAWOYDI reached over 10,000 via Growth Monitoring Exercise and Mid-Upper Arm Circumference (MUAC) measurement to assess nutritional status of children, those found yellow were referred to PHC while those found severely malnourished were not only referred to PHC but also the organization provide Compaq and Tomb Brown to them and regular follow up.

Education and awareness programs on nutrition, including the importance of exclusive breastfeeding, good nutrition during pregnancy, and a balanced diet. Fortification of staple foods, such as flour, oil, and salt, with essential nutrients. Micronutrient supplementation, like iron and folic acid supplementation for pregnant women.

Development of community gardens and other food production initiatives.



Key Achievements:

Education

Support for the improvement of the quality of education in North Eastern Nigeria through teacher training and provision of learning materials.

Support for the expansion of access to education, through construction of classrooms, provision IEC and scholastic Materials

Support for the development of policies and programs that promote education, through participation in strengthening of education laws and policies.

Support for the integration of life skills and values into the curriculum.

Good Governance

Under good governance FAWOYDI was able to achieve the following:

Capacity building of government officials and community members on issues of governance, such as transparency, accountability, and participation.

Support for the development of legal frameworks and policies that promote good governance through Open Governance Partnership

Support for the creation and strengthening of Community Coordinating Committee as independent oversight bodies

Support for the strengthening of civil society organizations that work on governance issues via partnership and collaborations.

Development of programs to increase citizen participation in decision-making processes

Training of community members on real time advocacy on issues bothering their communities



Child Protection

Raising awareness of child rights and protection issues among the community and government officials.

Training of community members, teachers, and other stakeholders on child protection issues, such as the prevention of child abuse and exploitation which led to formation of Child Protection Committees in various communities in collaboration with National Population Commission NPopC successfully registered and provide birth certificate to over ten thousand (10,000) children

Key Achievements:

Sustainable Agriculture

FAWOYDI reached more than 2000 women across various women farmer's group by providing:

Training on improved farming techniques, such as integrated pest management, organic farming, and irrigation

Provision of Groundnut processing machine, tiller machine, grinding machine, improved seedlings, etc

Training farmers on improved farming - Support for the development of agricultural infrastructure, such as irrigation systems and storage facilities.

Support for the development of agricultural value chains.

Support for the promotion of environmentally sustainable agriculture practices, via the use of climate smart agriculture, organic fertilizers and pest control methods.

Development of a strategic plan that outlines the organization's vision, mission, and goals.
